

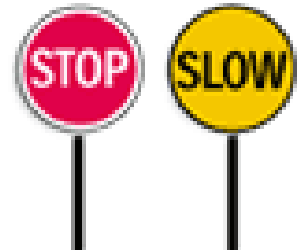


NSW Traffic Control Course (Stop/Slow Bat – Blue & Grey Card)

This one day course (*OHS Work Activity Training using Stop Slow Bat*) is for anyone intending to work, or is currently working, with traffic in a volunteer or employment basis. The Card is valid for 3 years. The photo Blue Card is required by anyone undertaking traffic control at a *construction* or *non-construction site*. The photo Grey Card is required by anyone undertaking traffic control at *non-construction* sites only.

Course content

- ✚ Workplace health and safety legislation (*Act, Regulations, Australian Standards, Codes of Practice*)
- ✚ Linking traffic control to construction work & the OHS legislation
- ✚ Role and responsibilities of Traffic Controllers
- ✚ Common requirements for Traffic Controllers
- ✚ Personal protective equipment (PPE) requirements
- ✚ Traffic controller procedures
- ✚ Selecting a suitable location and communicating between Traffic Controllers
- ✚ Assessing changes in traffic conditions
- ✚ When is a third Traffic Controller required
- ✚ Traffic Controller procedures
- ✚ How to react in an emergency
- ✚ Traffic Controlling at night
- ✚ Theory and Practical Assessments.
- ✚ Two way radio operation



Nominal course duration

- ✚ 7 hours

What to expect on the day

- ✚ A photo of each participant will be taken on the day (for the Traffic Control Photo Card)
- ✚ Morning - Theory and test (note that a high mark will be required in order to pass)
- ✚ Afternoon - Practical Test & Assessment of Competency (Stopping Traffic, Starting Traffic & using radios)

Course cost

- ✚ \$175 (exempt gst)
- ✚ Payment: Cash, Eftpos, MC, Visa, Amex, Diners Card or by cheque/invoice to approved accounts.

What to Bring

- ✚ Participants will need to bring safety shoes for the practical session.
- ✚ Safety Vests are supplied but participants are welcome to bring their own hi vis clothing
- ✚ Current WorkCover NSW OHS Construction Induction Card (White Card) *not required for Photo Grey Card*
- ✚ Evidence of a current or expired Drivers Licence (green P2 provisional or higher) **or**
- ✚ If claiming exemption from the Drivers licence requirement, a previous NSW Stop/Slow Photo Card (current or not more than 2 years expired)

Certification

- ✚ Successful participants will receive a Statement of Completion issued by the NSW RTA licenced trainer.
- ✚ The wallet size Traffic Controller Photo Card is sent direct to the participant after processing
- ✚ The NSW Traffic Control Stop Slow qualification is valid for 3 years.
